Gourmet grocer Raw Materials has sourced a classic trio of Easter goodies for 2014 – treats by producers who have practised their craft for several generations.

From Italy's Leone confectioners comes a tin drum, embossed with vintage characters from children's tales and filled with fruit jellies. The sweets are gluten free and come in apple, pear, peach, apricot, strawberry, orange and lemon flavours.

From Spain, there's a handcrafted chocolate treat by Luxocolat, a family business in Barcelona. Presented in a cage, an exquisitely decorated mother hen is surrounded by four wrapped eggs. Milan pastry house G. Cova produces one of the world's finest traditional Easter cakes. Its Colomba Pasquale has a signature soft, moist texture and is fashioned into a dove shape, topped with pearl sugar and almonds.
